

# Decade of Availability The Maturing Heart

"For everyone who asks receives,
and he who seeks finds,
and to him who knocks it will be opened."

Matthew 7:8

*Introduction:* In *Matthew 7:8* Jesus is teaching about our attitudes of the heart. These attitudes represent a progression or maturing of the heart. The verbs <u>ask</u>, <u>seek</u>, and <u>knock</u> indicate intensity. To seek is more intense than to ask and to knock is the most intense.

#### **I. The Asking Heart** Ask and it shall be given...

Asking implies a gift will be given. "The gift is ours for the asking." Such as salvation, forgiveness, healing, the Holy Spirit, wisdom, daily bread...

- A. **Two different attitudes** from the asking heart: One is to become so wrapped up in the gifts that we forget the giver. The other is to focus on the giver and be grateful for the gifts.
- B. We fail to ask because we are either too proud—self sufficient—or to fearful (underserving).
- C. **Remember** "He is our Father in Heaven" and "...every good and perfect gift comes from above." James 4:2-3

God gives gifts to the 'asking heart, but He has blessings that He only reveals to the 'seeking heart!

#### II. The **Seeking** Heart Seek and you will find...

The seeking heart will go after, pursue and search out. The shepherd went after the lost sheep, the woman searched diligently for the lost coin and the father looked afar for the lost son.

- A. The seeking heart is more fervent than the asking heart. Mt 6:33; Psa 27:8
- B. We will not know His treasures by asking—but by seeking. Col 2:3; Col 3:1-2; I Cor 3:1; Matt 7:6 God gives His gifts but guards His treasures!
- C. A seeking heart reveals our secret desire. Psa 63:1 "O God, You are my God; Early will I seek You." Ps 27:4 "One thing have I desired and will seek...that I may dwell in the house of the Lord." Isa 58:2 "Seek me day by day and delight to know my ways." Heb 11:6 "God rewards those who earnestly seek Him."

A seeking heart involves removing all our personal ambitions and desires that would hinder seeking Him.

**III.** The <u>Knocking</u> Heart Knock and it shall be opened to you... Knocking is the right use of the truth God has entrusted to us. Are we not responsible for the gifts and the treasures He has revealed to us?

A. **Knocking is connected with a door of opportunity**. In Matthew 25 the (immature) unfaithful servant 'dug a hole and hid his master's gifts.' The (mature) faithful servant 'put his masters gift to work and gained more.'

B. Three ways to go through doors: 1) Pick the lock 2) Break it down 3) Knock and let the Lord open it.

If we fail to <u>ASK</u>, we forfeit His gifts
If we fail to <u>SEEK</u> we lack the treasures of His Kingdom
If we refuse to <u>KNOCK</u> our Christian service will not bear fruit.

"But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ"

III John 1:2

James 4:2-3 (NKJV)

2 You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and war. Yet you do not have because you do not ask. 3 You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures.

Matthew 6:33 (NKJV)

33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth

And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual [seeking] people but as to carnal [asking], as to babes in Christ.

#### Matthew 7:6 (NKJV)

"Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces.


# **Soup Groups**
