

### The 10 Commandments **The Power of Purity** *The Seventh Commandment*

# The Bible and Sexuality

Why is God interested in this area of our life? Because He desires that we be <u>whole</u> emotionally, physically and spiritually. This commandment represents a core Biblical theme that is designed to create the character of purity within us!

#### A. God's <u>Creative</u> Masterpiece Mark 10:6-9 God's three-fold view of marriage:

- 1. Male and female: God created human sexuality.
- 2. Two become one: The power of oneness in marriage.
- **3.** Do not destroy: A lifelong commitment—covenant.

## B. God's *Covenant* Cement *Ex 20:14*

- Why is adultery, in all its forms, forbidden?
- **1. Not because sex is bad**: But because it is designed to be such a powerful force for good. It is the '**covenant cement**' that seals the love between a husband and wife.
- **2. The connection between sexuality and spirituality**: The union between a husband and wife is intended to exemplify the exclusive relationship between God and His people.
  - a. <u>In the Old Testament</u>: God often compared His relationship with his people to the romance between a husband and wife. When His people were unfaithful—they were guilty of committing spiritual adultery. *Jer 3:1-10; 5:7-11; Hos 2*
  - b. <u>In the New Testament</u>: The union between husband and wife exemplifies the union between Christ and His church. *Eph* 5:31-32; 1 Cor 6:13b-20

### C. God's Care For The Heart Matt 5:27-30

- **1. What is the heart**? The 'heart' in this passage represents the psychological total of our <u>mind</u>, <u>will</u>, <u>emotions</u> and <u>desires</u>.
  - a. <u>Desire and deeds</u>: The law governs our *inward thoughts* as well as our *outward actions*, it really is a matter of the heart.
  - a. <u>Out of the heart</u>: The heart is the '**incubator**' of all sexual sin. *Prov 23:7; Mat 15:19*
  - b. <u>Gateway to the heart</u>: We need to protect our heart by exposing it to the Word of God and what is pure—rather than what is impure. *Eph 5:3-4; Phil 4:8*

What we read...fantasy fiction, romance novels What we watch/see...movies, TV

What we hear/say...jokes and suggestive language **2. Get a heart check up:** Is your heart healthy? Is it pure?

- a. <u>Heaven maimed or hell whole</u>? According to Jesus it is better to get to heaven maimed than to hell, whole. *Mat 5:29-30* Jesus is saying we need to guard what we 'see' and what we 'touch.'
- b. <u>Heart cleansing</u>: "But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God." *1 Cor 6:11*

**Exodus 20:14** (NKJV) *:14* You shall not commit adultery.

## **Mark 10:6-9** (NKJV)

**:6** But from the beginning of the creation, God 'MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE.'

*:7* 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE,

**:8** AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'; so then they are no longer two, but one flesh.

**:9** Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate."

#### Matthew 5:27–30 (NKJV)

*:27* "You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY.'

**:28** But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her **in his heart**.

**:29** If your right **eye** causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

*:30* And if your right **hand** causes you to sin, cut it off and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell.

Eph 5:3 But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it <u>not even be named among you</u>, as is fitting for saints; :4 neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, <u>but rather giving of</u> <u>thanks</u>.
