

# Perfecting Discipleship:

## Discipleship and Joy

His Joy and My Joy
So far in the upper room

discourse Jesus has given the disciples His peace and love—now he imparts His joy.

*Introduction:* In *John 17:6-19* Jesus prays for us and His disciples. It is prayer for assurance, hope, security and protection. It's just the kind of prayer that I would want Jesus to pray for me. All that He teaches in the passage for this study—He prays about. What we learn in this passage—we should also pray about!

#### A. Love, Joy and Peace that Remain John 14:27; 15:9-11

- 1. In describing the fruit of the Spirit in *Gal 5:22* Paul lists love, joy, peace first.
- 2. Jesus gives us His:
  - a. Peace 14:27 ...living above trouble and fear
  - b. Love 15:10 ...abiding [resting] in God's will
  - c. Joy 15:11 ...living in the fullness of God

#### B. Fullness of Joy John 15:12-17

Here are three things that result in the 'remaining joy' of Jesus living in us—His joy becoming our joy:

- 1. Love one another: 12-13; 17 [Feet Washing John 13]
  - a. The disciple's attitude toward one another is critical to the future work of sharing the gospel.
  - b. Unity instead of rivalry, trust instead of suspicion, obedience instead of self-assertion.
  - c. The measure of their love for one another is how He loves them—which should cause them joy!

#### 2. Friendship with God:14-15

- a. A friend is a confidant who shares the knowledge of his superior's purpose and voluntarily adopts it as his own. [Abraham—Friend of God because of faith James 2:23]
- b. The disclosure of the mind of God concerning His will for them (and the world) would give them both assurance and joy that they were engaged in the right task.

## 3. Appointed Ministry:16

- a. The disciples were both chosen and appointed for service. They were both servants and friends. They were to go and 'manifest the life of God' to a world that did not know God.
- b. Mankind [the lost] was the 'joy' that Jesus saw [Heb 12:1-2] as He endured the cross . Our joy should be no less than His.

As branches we receive... As disciples we follow... As friends we commune...

## John 14:27

\*27 Peace I leave with you,

\*My peace\* I give to you; not as
the world gives do I give to you.

Let not your heart be troubled,
neither let it be afraid.

### John 15:9-17

- **:9** "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.
- :10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.
- :11 "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full [complete].
- :12 This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.
- :13 Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.
- :14 You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.
- :15 No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but <u>I have called you friends</u>, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.
- 216 You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.
- :17 These things I command you, that you love one another.
