Perfecting Faith: The Book of James Faith: Possessions and Patience



Two World Systems

One is the system that depends on wealth, possessions and power to be satisfied. The other is the system that says I will patiently wait and trust in Jesus and His return for the provisions for my life! Which system are you living under?

"These things I have spoken to you, that <u>in Me</u> you may have <u>peace</u>. <u>In the world</u> you will have <u>tribulation</u>; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." **Jesus** John 16:33

A. Pain of Possessions James 5:1-6

Misuse of possessions [wealth] can bring pain in four areas:

- 1. <u>Emotional pain from misuse of possessions</u> :1 Possessions are destined to break—they will not bring happiness. 1 *Tim* 6:10
- 2. <u>Physical pain because I store up my possessions</u> :2-3 Hording possessions thinking it will bring security and happiness will only bring pain. *Matt 6:19-21; 1 Tim 6:6-9; Psa 62:10; Prov 22:1*
- 3. <u>Relational pain because I steal from those in need</u>:4 This principle speaks to all who ignore the needs of others. *Deut 24:14-15 God [The Lord of Hosts] hears the cries of the oppressed.* **Do we?**
- 4. <u>Spiritual pain because I spend selfishly on myself</u>:5-6 Luxury here means 'to break down.' When I am consumed with possessions it will break me down spiritually. *Matt* 6:19-20

B. Power of Patience James 5:7-11

- <u>Patience will strengthen your heart</u>: 7-8
 Waiting for Jesus' provision: Instead of building
 my life around possessions I need to live my life with
 patience. My heart will be strengthened
 through patience.
- <u>Patience will strengthen your relationships</u> :9
 Waiting for Jesus to judge: Instead of judging others I let patience have its perfect work in me. Jam 1:4; [2 Pet 3:3-9 God's patience]
- 3. <u>Patience will strengthen us through suffering</u> :10-11 *Waiting for Jesus to bless with compassion and mercy:* James is writing to a suffering church that needed instruction, comfort and encouragement.
 - The prophets *Heb* 11:36-39

Pain of Possessions James 5:1-6

:1 Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you!
:2 Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are motheaten.

:3 Your gold and silver are corroded, and their corrosion will be a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have heaped up treasure in the last days.

:4 Indeed the wages of the laborers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, <u>cry out</u>; and the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth. *[Hosts]*:5 You have lived on the earth in pleasure and luxury; you have fattened your hearts as in a day of slaughter.

:6 You have condemned, you have murdered the just; he does not resist you.

Power of Patience

James 5:7-11

:7 Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See *how* the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain.

:8 You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand. **:9** Do not grumble against one another, brethren, lest vou be condemned. Behold, the Judge is standing at the door! :10 My brethren, take the prophets, who spoke in the name of the Lord, as an example of suffering and patience. **:11** Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end *intended* by the Lord-that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.
