Hatred for Israel Will Increase in 2008 and Beyond: Why?

Hatred for Israel will increase among the nations *(Zech 14:2)*. This hatred will not be as much about the land, politics, or Zionism but because of what Israel represents by her national existence.

In the Bible Israel is the one political nation on earth that points to God in at least 7 ways by her very existence.

1. Israel identifies the one true God by name: Jehovah. The God of creation is revealed personally through Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (Israel).

6. Israel's biological line is the identifying factor of the one Messiah-Savior, Jesus Christ our Lord (*Rom 9:5*).

7. Israel will be the capital seat of power of God's Messiah-Son on earth in the kingdom age that replaces Satan's control. (*Isa 2*).
