

Perfecting Joy: The Book of Philippians Joy In Loving Others

At the heart of this passage is unity among the believers. This is a universal appeal to the Church to be 'one' in Christ the Messiah and to love each other. This is **REAL JOY**!

### A. There is Joy in Loving Others Because of ... Phil 2:1

The word "if" in this verse is better understood as "since"

- 1. My encouragement in Christ *Acts 9:27* <u>Since</u> there is so much encouragement in Christ...
- 2. My consolation of love *1 Thes 5:14* <u>Since</u> His love has such a persuasiveness...
- 3. My fellowship of the Spirit *2 Cor 6:14-18* <u>Since</u> the Holy Spirit brings us all together...
- 4. My affection and compassion <u>Since</u> there is so much tender affection and mercy...

With all that there is in Christ, the members of His Body should have unity of purpose, affection, accord, and sympathy.

#### **B. There is Joy in Loving Others when we will...** *Phil 2:2-4*

Paul says, "Fulfill my joy..." in these six things...

- 1. Be of the same mind [like minded] :2
- 2. Maintain the same love :2
- 3. Be united in spirit [being of one accord] :2
- 4. Be intent on one purpose [of one mind] :2
- 5. Remove selfishness [esteem others] :3
- 6. Regard others as more important :4

The word '<u>others</u>' in vs. 4 is the key to this passage. As we give our lives for others we rise above the selfish strife of men.

#### C. There is Joy in Loving Others as Jesus did...

Verse :5 "Let this mind be in you…" connects the 'like mindedness' and 'of one mind' of verse :2 to the example of Christ.

- 1. Jesus is the <u>selfless</u> preexistent God in heaven :6
- 2. Jesus is the  $\frac{1}{\text{servant}}$  to us taking the form of a man :7
- 3. Jesus is <u>sacrificial</u> for us by dying for us on the cross :8

# D. There is Joy in Loving Others because of the NAME of Jesus... *Phil 2:9-10*

The name of Jesus is above all other names. And it is upon His name that we live our lives with joy. "Rejoice in the Lord [the name of Jesus] always." *Phil 4:4* 

## Philippians 2:1-11

**:1** Therefore if *there is* any <u>consolation</u> in Christ, if any <u>comfort</u> of love, if any <u>fellowship</u> of the Spirit, if any <u>affection</u> and mercy,

**:2** fulfill my joy by being <u>like-minded</u>, having the <u>same</u> <u>love</u>, *being* of <u>one accord</u>, of <u>one</u> <u>mind</u>.

**:3** Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself.

:4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

**:5** Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,

**:6** who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,

*:7* but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men.

**:8** And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross.

**:9** Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,

**:10** that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,

**:11** and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
