## How To Be a Light in a Troubled World

**Intro:** Have you heard the voice of the Bridegroom today? He must increase; I must decrease. (*John 3*) This is the great theme of living for and serving Christ with joy.

## A. The Goal of Every Believer Phil 2:12-13

1. <u>I will live my salvation in all areas of my life</u> :12

Work out my salvation: This is the process of 'sanctification.' Becoming more and more like Jesus every day-conformed to His image. Obedience: Faithful submission to God's will. Personal Responsibility: Living for Christ in private and Key in public, in the sacred and the secular. **Understanding the consequences of sin**: The fear of the Thought Lord is the beginning of wisdom." Psa 111:10 We are to 2. I will be empowered by God :13 work out While the believer is 'working out' [Vs :12] what God God is 'working in." [Vs :13] has God's Purpose: God supplies the energy for us to worked follow Him-to work out our salvation and to do His will. <u>into</u> us. What is that energy? It is the Holy Spirit: John 14:16-17; 1 Cor. 6:19-20 B. How Every Believer Should Reach the Goal Phil 2:14-18 1. I will remove these things :14 Grumbling-Complaining [murmuring] Gk gonguzo where we get the English word 'gong.' 1 Cor 10:10 **Disputing-**A contrary spirit; arguing for the primary sake of winning the argument. James 2:4 2. <u>I will become these</u> :15 Blameless-That you may give no occasion for others to accuse you of having done wrong. Luke 1:5-6 Innocent-[Harmless] Without any mixed motive or deceit. Matt 10:16 3. <u>I will reveal these</u> :15-16 *Light* – How I live God's Word Gk: phos-the essence or source of light! One who exposes the light of God's word. Compare John 8:12 and Matt 5:14 where both Jesus and believers are called the 'light' [phos] of the world. *Truth* – What I teach of God's Word Gk: logos-the very Word of God. John 1:1 To 'hold fast' means to hang on to; to pay attention to. Heb 2:1 4. It will result in this :17-18. Joyful...Sacrifice - For Christ: [See Num 28:7] The OT drink offering was poured out over an animal sacrifice and the wine would vaporize. The steam symbolized the rising of the offering to God. Joyful...Service – For Christ: This is a picture of priestly service. The Philippians were offering their lives sacrificially and faithfully in service to God.



Philippians 2:12–18 :12 Therefore, my beloved, as you have always <u>obeyed</u>, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, *work out* your own salvation with <u>fear and</u> trembling;

*:13* for it is God who *works in* you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure.

**:14** Do all things without complaining and disputing,

**:15** that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world,

**:16** holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

**:17** Yes, and if I am being poured out *as a <u>drink offering</u>* on the sacrifice and service of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all.

**:18** For the same reason you also be glad and rejoice with me.
