

Perfecting Joy: The Book of Philippians Joy of Growing In Christ

It is comforting to know that we are all: **A work in progress!** God was not done with the Apostle Paul when he wrote this passage and God is not done with you either.

A. Growing To Maturity With Joy Phil 3:12-16

1. Who is perfect?

<u>Perfect</u>: To reach a goal, fulfill a purpose, complete *There are three kinds of spiritual perfection*

- a. Positional: As God sees me Heb 10:14
- b. <u>Progressive</u>: As others see me 2 Cor 7:1
- c. <u>Ultimate</u>: As seen in heaven (See "C" below :20-21)

2. What does it mean to grow?

- a. <u>Keep on keeping on</u> (press on) :12; 14 Pursue a specific goal
- b. <u>Forget the past</u> :13 Remember the past but do not live in it
- c. <u>Reach forward</u> :13 Laying hold of the plow Luke 9:62 d. Crow togother as a Church :15 16
- d. <u>Grow together as a Church</u> :15-16 Grow up in all things into Him... Eph 4:7-16

B. Walking the Walk With Joy Phil 3:17-19

As we walk through this life we encounter both the good and the bad. The one who walks with the 'joy' of the Lord knows the difference. *Psalm 16:11 In His presence is fullness of joy!*

1. **The good** :17

Those who are an example of the faith; our spiritual fathers and mothers; those who demonstrate the character of Christ in their walk.

2. The bad :18-19

- *The following are enemies of the cross of Christ :18* a. <u>Hedonism</u>: Pleasure is the only goal *:19 If it feels good do it*
 - b. <u>Narcissism</u>: It's all about me *:19 If it makes me look good—it's good*
 - c. <u>Secularism</u>: Exclusion of the religion :19 Secular (non-Biblical) thought is superior to Biblical or religious thought.

C. Joy When This Life is Over Phil 3:20-21

Ultimate Perfection: This is the third type of spiritual perfection

- 1. <u>Heavenly citizenship</u>: Our passport to heaven is already sealed by the Holy Spirit while we fulfill the call of the Gospel here. *:20*
- 2. <u>Transformed body</u>: We will be like Him in our own glorified bodies. *1 Cor 15:42-49*

Philippians 3:12-21

:12 Not that I have already attained, or am already (A1) <u>perfected</u>; but I (A2 a) <u>press</u> <u>on</u>, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

:13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, (A2 b) forgetting those things which are behind and (A2 c) reaching forward to those things which are ahead,

:14 I (A2 a) <u>press toward</u> the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

:15 Therefore let us, (A2 d) <u>as</u> <u>many as are mature, have this</u> <u>mind</u>; and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal even this to you.

:16 Nevertheless, to *the degree* that we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us be of the same mind.

:17 Brethren, join in following my example, and note those who so walk, as you have us for a pattern.

:18 For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* the enemies of the cross of Christ:

:19 whose end *is* destruction, (B2 a) <u>whose god *is their* belly</u>, and (B2 b) <u>whose glory *is* in their shame</u>— (B2 c) <u>who set their mind</u> <u>on earthly things</u>.

:20 For our (C1) <u>citizenship is</u> <u>in heaven</u>, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

:21 who will (C2) <u>transform our</u> <u>lowly body</u> that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.
