

Perfecting Prayer **Praying the Word**

According to Thy Word!

"Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her." Luke 1:38

Mary's declaration, "Let it be to me according to your word," captures the heart of what it means

to 'pray the Word.' The angel had spoken God's word to her—and her response was to make a 'declaration' based on God's Word.

Praying the Word: Praying the Word is praying scripture (God's Word) back to God. It is prayer that declares the truth of God's Word over a person, situation, nation or my own heart.

A. Lift Up the Word Psalm 119:171-172

"My lips shall utter praise... My tongue shall speak of Your Word"

- To 'utter' means to 'gush forth' which may be similar to praying in the spirit or in tongues. *John 7:37-39*
- To 'speak' here means to lift up—which would include prayer.

B. Rain Down the Word Isaiah 55:8-11

This passage teaches us that God honors His Word. It seems natural then for us to call upon Him to perform what He has declared. God's Word NEVER fails to achieve its aims.

C. Hope In the Word Psalm 119:145-149

When I 'pray the Word' I am proclaiming and calling out with my voice the Words of God—my salvation and my hope. Here the psalmist rises before dawn and prays through the day and meditates all through the night.

D. Abide In the Word John 15:7; 1:1-2

To abide in in Jesus and for His Words to abide in us we must read the Word and pray the Word (the Bible).

E. Rest in the Authority of the Word? *Hebrews 4:12-13* Too often our experiences become the 'sovereign text' of our lives rather than the sovereign text of God's Word.

F. Pray the Word: Psalm 23

The Lord is my shepherd... You are the Shepherd of my life I shall not want... Today I have need of nothing He maketh me to lie down in green pastures... Today I rest in God He leads me beside the still waters... I will be still and know God He restores my soul... I am complete in You He leads me in paths of righteousness... Today I will walk in Holiness Yea though I walk... There is NO fear in You and death is only a shadow that your Light dispels For thou art with me... *I am never alone* Your rod and thy staff... You are the only comfort I seek You prepare a table... I will live in the strength that You provide You anoint my head with oil... my mind will be at rest with God My cup runs over... I will drink ONLY from my Father's cup Surely goodness and mercy... goodness and mercy are God's gifts to me I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever... My only home is with God and today I am at home with Him.

Praying Protection
