O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Psa 95:1

I. Becoming a Part of God's Family: 13-17 How does a person become part of God's family

How does a person become part of God's family?

- 1. Who do men say that I am? :13
- 2. But who do you say that I am? :15
 - a. Peter's answer :16

"You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." You are the Messiah-the Son of the living God.

b. How did Peter know this? :17

It is the power of God working in our heart that reveals to us who He is! Read the gospel of John and ask God to reveal to you who He is.

II. Growing God's Family: Building on a Rock :18-19

- 1. Who or what is the rock? :18
 - Christ
 - Peter
 - Peter's Confession

What did Peter have to say? I Peter 2:4-10

Living stones...Chief cornerstone...

God is the rock of my salvation (Psa 95:1) but the Church is built on the 'confession' that Jesus is the Messiah and He will build His Church on that confession.

2. The power of the Rock :18

Death and hell can NOT keep us from the love of God.

3. The Keys to the Kingdom :19

Authority: The gatekeeper had the power to lock out or let in.

a. How are the Keys used?

The Church is the REALM The Kingdom is the REIGN

The focus: Is on Jesus as the KING and His reign but His kingdom power is worked out in the 'realm' of the Church, the Body Of Messiah!

By extension: Through prayer, fasting and 'being in one accord' we as the Body of Messiah can benefit from the 'reigning' power of the King (Jesus). *Acts 2:4; 14*

I Will Give You Rest

How to Rest in God....

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.

1. Go to the source :28

And He said, My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest. Exo 33:14

And it shall come to pass in the day that the LORD shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear, and from the hard bondage... Isa 14:3



2. Identify the Burden :28

Matt 23:4

Laboring under the strength of our own efforts.

3. Receive the Rest :28

Cast your burden on the Lord,
And He shall sustain you;
He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.
Psalm 55:22

This is a rest that ONLY GOD can give to you. *Heb 3:6: 10-11: 4:11-12*

4. Walk in His Rest :29

Being YOKED with God.

- Dependence
- Submission
- Personalization
- Purpose
- Power

For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus. *NASB Phil 1:6*

And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. *NKJV: Phil 4:19*
