So I went to the angel, telling him to give me the little book.

And he said to me, "Take it and eat it; it will make your stomach bitter, but in your mouth it will be sweet as honey."

Rev 10:9

1. The Book: The Word

- All of creation was formed by the spoken WORD: God spoke a word and it came into being. *Gen 1-2*
- Jesus is called the "Word" John 1:1
- Jesus is called the "Bread of life" John 6:35

2. Eat This Book

- a. Those commanded to eat the book...
 - 1. John Rev 10:9
 - 2. Ezekiel Eze 2:8-10; Eze 3:1-3
 - 3. Jeremiah Jer 15:16
- b. Taste and see...

Psa 19:9-10; Psa 119:103; Psa 34:8

3. Most read the book-Bible in one of four ways

- 1. <u>The Scholar</u>: Detailed study of the language, history, culture, geography...
- 2. <u>The Counselor</u>: Practical study; directions, formulas, living healthy, wealthy, and wise...
- 3. <u>The Inspirational</u>: Devotional study; comfort for the needy, hurting and those in grief...
- 4. The Sovereignty of God: Total submission to God. Incorporating all of the first three styles of study and reading--but not depending on or focusing on one to the exclusion of the others...

4. How do we eat the Book—the Bible?

Like food to the body—the Bible is manna/food for the spirit, soul and body:

- *Eating*: Read the text under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Joh 16:13-15
- **Digesting**: Meditate on the text Jos 1:8; Psa 1:2
- Nourishment: Pray the text 1Th 5:17
- *Strengthening*: Live the text *Joh 4:34*

Scripture reveals everything of who God is—but it also reveals everything of who I am. Eating the book is receiving the Word in such a way that it becomes the text of who I am. The 'sovereign' text of my life is no longer my self—but the sovereign God.
