A. The Character of God in the 7 Churches

Jesus calls HIMSELF these things when addressing the 7 churches.

Holds the seven stars in his right hand;
Walks in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;
The first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;
Has the sharp sword with two edges; Eyes like unto a
flame of fire; Feet are like fine brass; Has the seven
Spirits of God; And the seven stars; Holy and true;
Has the key of David; The Amen; Faithful and true
witness; The beginning of the creation of God

B. The Character of God in the "NAME"

There are a number of instances where no name of God is used, but simply the term "name" in reference to God as a point of focus to His character:

(Gen. 12:8; 13:4) (Ex. 33:19; 34:5) (Lev. 13:21; 22:2, 32) (Ex. 20:7; Deut. 5:11) (Deut. 18:5; 21:5) (Judges 13:18) (Gen. 21:33; 26:25)

In the New Testament we find the same, where "name" is used to focus on the character of Jesus:

(John 1:12) (Matt. 18:20) (John 14:13-14) (Matt. 10:22) (Acts 4:18; 5:28, 41; 10:43; 19:17) (Phil. 2:10-11)

C. The Character of God For His Name's Sake

Things done by, for and in the 'name' of the God!

(Psa 23:3) (Psa 31:3) (Psa 79:9) (Psa 106:8) (Psa 143:11) (Mat 10:22) (Mat 19:29) (Mat 24:9)

(1Jo 2:12) (Rev 2:3)

D. The Character of God in Jesus' Name Isaiah 9:6

- Wonderful (or Wonderful Counselor)
- Counselor
- The mighty God
- The everlasting Father
- The Prince of Peace
 - **1. Higher Than Any Other Name** *Phil 2:9-11* Includes all the names listed in Isa 9:6
 - 2. What/Who Will Bow To The Name Of Jesus? Anything that has a name bows to the name of Jesus Christ including sickness and disease. *Acts 3:1-7; 16*

The Church at Sardis

Was Dedicated but Dead

Revelation 3:1-6

1. The Character of Jesus 3:1

The emphasis seems to be upon watching and empowering through the Holy Spirit and the pastors-ministers over the church. (See Rev 5:6)

2. The Approval

There is NO approval for this church. And, there is no mention of persecution. Satan did not need to persecute them, they were already dead.

3. The Criticism

- a. <u>Living on past achievements</u>: 1

 They had the appearance of life but in reality were dead—like the glory of Gideon's victory which was short lived.

 Judges 8:27
- b. Never finish what is started :2

 A lot of energy, planning, expense but never seeing a harvest.

4. The Advice

a. Look to the past :3

Remember: What you heard and received

b. Look to the present :2

Be watchful and become strong in the Lord Hold fast and repent (:3)

c. Look to the future

There is hope: There are a few faithful left in Sardis. (:4)

• A Warning (:3) I am coming as a thief in the night! 1 Thes 5:2-4; 2 Pet 3:10.

5. The Assurance

- a. Walk: (reign) with Christ (:4) Clothed in white...
- b. <u>Salvation</u>: Name permanently recorded in the book of life. (:5)
- c. Well Done: Public recognition before the throne (:5)
