# Parables of Jesus—The Kingdom



## Growth of the Kingdom (...in Our Community)

### Faith and Power To Change the World

These two parables go together to teach a two-fold message of how the kingdom of God is to impact our world between the time of the Messiah's first and second advents. Both parables a full of hope and encouragement.

Introduction: After hearing the parables about the four types of soil Matt 13:3-9; 18-23 and the wheat and tares Mat 13:24-30; 36-43, the disciples may have wondered how or even IF the kingdom would ever grow.

### A. Parable of The Mustard Seed Mat 13:31-32 <u>Faith</u> to Change the World

- 1. A small beginning
  - a. The birth of a kingdom Isaiah 9:6-7
  - b. Jesus grew up among the least promising towns
  - c. His first disciples were few in number and slow to understand and believe
  - d. When He was gone, only about 120 were left to pray about the future *Acts* 1:15
- 2. The growth
  - a. Grow the kingdom... Mat 28:17-20
  - b. Grow in faith... Mat 17:20
- 3. A place of refuge
  - a. Nesting carries the idea of protection, safety, refuge, sanctuary and growth. *Acts 2:40-47*

#### B. Parable of the Leaven Mat 13:33 Power to Change the World

- 1. <u>Small things can have great influence</u>: The power of the kingdom of heaven is great through a single believer.
- 2. <u>Leavened bread and the influence of the *Holy Spirit*:</u> Only unleavened bread was eaten during the 'Feast of the Unleavened Bread,' which began on Passover evening and lasted seven days. *Exo* 12:15; 18-19
  - a. At the feast of Pentecost the bread offered to the Lord HAD TO be baked with leaven. *Lev 23:17*
  - b. When the *Holy Spirit* was poured out on the Day of Pentecost is was a sign of the coming influence of the Spirit of God in the world.
- 3. <u>Influence from within</u>: The leaven must be hidden to have any impact. This is not a hiding so as not to be seen but hiding in the sense of going deep.
  - a. Christians are not to be of the world, but in the world, because that is the only way the gospel can reach and affect the world. *Joh* 17:14-16
  - b. As Jesus was sent into the world—so He sends us *Joh 17:18*. The purpose of the Church is to "go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." *Mar 16:15*

### Mathew 13:31–32 Mustard Seed

\*31 Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and sowed in his field,

:32 which indeed is the least of all the seeds; but when it is grown it is greater than the herbs and becomes a tree, so that the <u>birds of the air</u> come and <u>nest</u> in its branches."

\*33 Another parable He spoke to them: "The kingdom of heaven is like <u>leaven</u>, which a woman took and <u>hid</u> in three measures of meal <u>till it was all</u> leavened."
